



Act Now on New Master Builder Incentives: THIN-GLASS TRIPLE-PANE WINDOWS



INCENTIVES

Incentives for installing thin center glass triple-pane windows are now available for single family and multifamily California Advanced Home Program participants. **Each home or unit receives an additional \$6 per square foot of glazing.***



THIN-GLASS TRIPLE-PANE WINDOWS

Thin-glass, triple-pane windows can be installed in the same window openings as double-pane windows, are significantly more energy efficient, and reduce the energy needed to maintain a comfortable temperature.



INCENTIVE REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for Master Builder window incentives, projects must:

- ✓ 2016 code projects: be a current, active project enrolled in the 2016 code CAHP
- ✓ 2019 code projects: achieve a delta EDR of 1
- ✓ Install windows by December 1, 2020
- ✓ Complete projects in climate zones 11, 12, or 13 with a limited number of incentivized homes per project, to be determined with PG&E on a case-by-case basis
- ✓ Permit PG&E to:
 - Observe the installation
 - Access incremental cost data with invoices (material and labor)
 - Use collected data in case studies or marketing materials
- ✓ Comply with program-approved thin-glass, triple-pane window: a triple-pane window with a thin center pane of glass ($\leq 2\text{mm}$ thick), fitting into a typical double-pane window frame with an NFRC-rated U-factor ≤ 0.22 and SHGC as per Title 24 code*
